The NRT Leonard and Marydee Flynn Environmental Scholarship

The NRT Leonard and Marydee Flynn Environmental Scholarship is a \$2,000 scholarship awarded by the Natural Resources Trust of Mansfield to either one (\$1,000 each) or two (\$2,000 to one) Mansfield students who have demonstrated a commitment to the environment.

Leonard and Marydee Flynn were founding members of the Natural Resources Trust of Mansfield and were lifelong conservationists and tireless advocates of preserving and protecting the environment. The NRT's goal is to preserve and protect Mansfield's natural resources for current and future generations.

Lenny served as president of the NRT for 18 years. Under his leadership, the NRT, working with the Mansfield Conservation Commission and other agencies, acquired over 800 acres of land for passive recreation in Mansfield. Leonard lived in Mansfield for 48 years and died in 2015 at the age of 81. Marydee championed the establishment of our Great Woods acquisition plan and negotiated with the landowners to sell or gift hundreds of acres of land to the Town and NRT. Marydee was married to Lenny for 53 years. She died in 2022 at age 85. This scholarship is dedicated to the Flynn's and to their passion for land conservation.

Scholarship Requirements:

We would like to award this scholarship to Mansfield students, either entering or already in college, who have evidenced a proven commitment to conservation or preserving the environment.

Scholarship Application:

 - a) outlining what you have done to foster conservation or preservation of the environment,
 - b) explaining your post-secondary plans and how you would use the scholarship money.
